

Raven Rock Mountain Complex

The Raven Rock Mountain Complex (RRMC) (Site R) is a deep underground relocation facility located in Adams County Pennsylvania. The site sits 6 miles from Camp David in Catoclin Mountain Park in Maryland. It is home to the department of defense as well as the Alternate National Military Command Center (ANMCC). The facility is commonly Referred to as the "underground Pentagon".

Construction of RRMC:

In 1950. President Harry Truman approved the top secret project. One half million cubic yards was blasted out and hauled away in just ten months. Three underground buildings were constructed, each three stories tall. Buildings A, B and D were constructed in 1953. 10 Years later buildings D and E were added.

In 1989 work began on a 13.5 million dollar project that intended to improve cooling systems for the computer systems inside the command center. A new tunnel was constructed to access a second underground reservoir. Water cooling towers and structural bracing were also added as well as a fire detection and sprinkling system.


1990 RRMC freedom of information act:


